Achieving Gender Transformative Education

- ♦ What is needed to teach **learners** gender equality?
- ♦ What do gender equal **schools** look like?
- ♦ How can the **community** support gender equal schools and learners?
- ♦ How should the **education system** guarantee the right to gender equality?

Learning Lessons from Successful Advocacy

- ♦ Lessons from successes in global health and education, e.g. investment in vaccines, support for early childhood education, dedicated funding for education in emergencies
- ♦ Tactics from rights movements including abortion rights in Central and South America, human rights in Turkey and LGBTQI+ rights in many countries
- ♦ Top ten gender equality, child rights that education should protect

Coming together for a Whole-Girl Approach

- ♦ Articulating a singular girls' rights agenda that brings together SRHR, GBV, child marriage, FGM, HIV, climate justice and child labour with educational priorities including foundational learning, digital literacy, out of school children
- ♦ Emancipating boys from patriarchy

Decolonising Data and Research

- ♦ Elevating and centering developing country data, research expertise
- ♦ How to count disability, LGBTQI+ and other minority identities in gender-responsive ways
- ♦ What can data and evidence learn from feminist storytelling traditions?
